


ARE YOU BEING DISCREET ONLINE?

By not showing your house number and turning off geolocation, you won't be revealing your **full postal address**.

By not showing how old you are turning or pointing out that your birthday is today, you won't be revealing your **date of birth**.

Both the postal address and date of birth are commonly used to verify your identity. Be in control of who can see what you are posting by checking your privacy settings
